RENEWAL DEADLINE EXTENDED FOR AFFECTED AREAS

Dear Wholesalers/Distributors,

As you are well aware, there are several areas in Louisiana affected by the disaster that included numerous businesses with alcohol and tobacco permits that are up for renewal.

In effort to avoid further disruption to these areas, a fifteen (15) day extension has been granted to businesses located in the affected area listed below. This extension shall allow any businesses who held a valid permit up until August 31, 2016 to continue to operate on their current valid permit until September 15, 2016 and provide additional time for these businesses to submit their renewal application to ATC. This extension shall only apply to businesses within the following affected areas: East Feliciana Parish, West Feliciana Parish, Livingston Parish, Washington Parish, St. Helena Parish, Tangipahoa Parish and parts of St. Tammany including Covington, Madisonville/Goodbee Folsom.

This extension shall also apply to any wholesalers and/or distributors whose customers are in the affected area. Businesses who were granted this extension were not issued a temporary permit, instead are granted an extension to continue to operate on their current alcohol and/or tobacco permit. For this reason, wholesalers and distributors may continue to sell and deliver products to their customers (located in the areas listed above and who held a valid alcohol or tobacco permit up until August 31, 2016).
